FOCUS: **Praying for each other**

Pray for November Opportunities:

- ⇒ Pray for the Elder Board Forum November 8th , from 6:30-8:00pm, to communicate needed information to congregation as well as to give opportunity for the elders to hear people’s concerns. Let us “be unified in the Spirit in the bond of peace” (Ephesians 4:3).
- ⇒ Pray that events for Missions Weekend (November 10-12^h) will be well attended. May God’s heart for the nations be understood and the next steps taken. Ask that our commitment to the Malay would be reinforced and strengthened.
- ⇒ Pray for the sermon series as our pastors prepare and deliver. May God give them the words to speak that would encourage and equip us (I Peter 4:8). Ask that each of us would truly engage with God and grow in our love for Him.
- ⇒ Pray that the events for youth would be well attended, safe and life changing as the good news about Jesus is shared. Lift up the JAM (6th-8th graders) lock-in on November 10th. May all “grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ and to be filled up to all the fullness of God (Ephesians 3:19).
- ⇒ Ask God to supply volunteers for Romp ‘n Stomp, First Impressions, Worship Arts and Sunday School. May the Shepherd of the sheep, our Lord Jesus, equip them with everything good for doing His will and work in them what is pleasing to Him (Hebrews 13:20-21).
- ⇒ Pray for members to contribute financially as God leads and to use their spiritual gifts as the Holy Spirit directs.
- ⇒ Pray for the Operation Christmas Child collection to have the needed workers to organize and record the donations. Ask God to use what is in each box to enable each child to grasp the love that He has for them. Pray we would be generous and wise in how we give and share with those in need.
- ⇒ Ask the Lord to give us thankful hearts that acknowledge all the good He daily gives us. May our celebrations focus on what He has done for us and in us.
